Constitutional amendments

Committee Quorum:

Nat proposes, Jono seconds that: *"7.1.5 The quorum for all committee meetings shall be 50% of the incumbent committee members."* is replaced with *"7.1.5 The quorum for all committee meetings shall be 30% of the incumbent committee members."* Note this amendment was immediately superseded by a following amendment.

Following that amendment Mike proposes, Dinny seconds that: *"7.1.5 The quorum for all committee meetings shall be 50% of the incumbent committee members."* is replaced with *"7.1.5 The quorum for all committee meetings shall be 30% of the incumbent committee members and a minimum of 3."*
